GARLAND WINS JUNIORS
99th USA Nationals Next



Hello Again..... There was no surprise in Bloomington, IN where Germantown (PA) Academy's Kyle Garland (18, Fort Washington, PA), won the USA Junior decathlon title. The 6-5, 210 lb prep senior was the entire story while winning 5 of 10 events and running up a nice 7562 total with the international junior implements.

After posting a nifty 10.95 clocking in the sprint he was never headed and a 15.55m/51- ¼ shot and 2.03m/6-8 high jump sealed the deal. His 13.80 hurdle clocking ('39') was the highlight of the 2nd day.

High Point freshman Gabriel Stainback was the runner-up at 6971 while a pair of Missouri prep stars, Peyton Davis and Isaiah Martin were 3rd and 4th reversing their Great SouthWest places.

Abele's Comeback Wins at Ratingen

German veteran (soon to be 32) Arthur Abele won the IAAF CE Challenge

meeting in Ratingen with a fine 8481 score. Speedy Manuel Eitel's 8121 was a digit better than ex UCLA star Marcus Nilsson/SWE. Last year's Thorpe Cup winner Ituah Enahoro, who competed for Germany then, was back competing for native Nigeria in this meet (see IAAF results page) and he scored 8048 for 5th. NCAA D-II champ Florian Obst improved to 8012 for 6th.

Most impressive were some individual marks run up by France's Kevin Mayer... 10.66 sprint, 15.86m/52½, 48.33 400m, 13.78 hurdles, 52.38m/171-10 discus and 5.20m/17-¾ vault for 5569 points in 6 events!

For the 3rd time Jim Duncan Stadium at Drake University will play host to the USA national senior decathlon, and this will be the 99th national meet which began in 1915 at the San Francisco Pan-Pacific Exposition (World's Fair). The meet is scheduled for Thurs-Fri, June 21-22. Among the 20 entries Gabe Moore/Arkansas and Hunter Veith/Wichita St have withdrawn for injury reasons but Stanford's Harrison Williams, who suffered a damaging leg injury two weeks back in Eugene (7 stitches) is on the entry list. Olympian Zach Ziemek will go to the sprint



starting line as the favorite.
