## SMALL COLLEGES COMPLETE

## **Obst, Flood, Gandy Win National Crowns**

Hello Again......The second day of the USA small(er) college weekend is complete with a trio of new champions. The D-II meet in Bradenton was a high scoring affair with German Florian Obst's 7576 effort getting the nod over Tanner McNutt's 7406. Central Missouri senior Blake Seitz came on with a rush placing 3rd at 7362. All three scores were personal bests.

Cortland senior Jack Flood survived a few scares but held up to win the D-III meet in Geneva, OH while scoring 6998 points.

The NAIA nationals saw a shuffle of places in the last few events but Central Methodist senior Drew Gandy finished strongly to win at 6855. Southern Oregon's Joe Dotson used a 4:22.18 last event to nip first day leader Winston lawson/Vanguard for the silver medal.

As I head to Mosle Stadium for the start of the 43rd Hypo-Bank meeting in Götzis, here is a summary of the USA action.

#### **NCAA II**

Bradenton, FL.....The very competitive NCAA D-II affair I was settled during the pole vault when Texas A&M freshman (24!, Emmeling, Germany) Florian Obst turned back Tanner McNutt, a junior at Pittsburg St (KS). Any chance of derailing the high flying German whould have to occur here but Obst's 4.90m/16-3/4 PR was a bar higher than McNutt and the meet was over, not uncommon because a recent study indicated that, after 9 events at major decathlons, there are no

changes in the order of the top three places 86% of the time.

Even more important in Bradenton, FL (high of 87°, light breezes all day) were those who did not get to the finish line. Seasonal leader Phill Bailey/Chico State and Azusa Pacific soph Corey Reid, both projected high finishers, suffered injuries and dnf'd.

Obst's final tally was a PR 7576 while McNutt also came up with a career best 7406 score. Chico State, projected for big team points here placed 5th (Jason Dunn) and 7th (Lane Andrews).

Geneva, OH...Day two of the NCAA D-II champs in Geneva, OH were met with rain, temps no higher than 63°. Cortland senior Jack Flood, who narrowly escaped a long jump mishap yesterday, lost his overall lead to teammate Connor Christopherson during the discus, regained it during the vault and went on to a solid 6998 win. Williams junior Tobias Muellers edged Christopherson for 2nd.

Most of the second day attraction came in the vault where Johns Hopkins senior Andrew Barnett dominated. He was no longer a contender after a hurdles 'DQ' but went on to clear a meet record 5.30m/17-4½.

Gulf Port, AL....sunny weather prevailed but Vanguard senior Winston Lawson (Santa Ana, CA) lost his bid to win the oldest collegiate nationals (began in 1969, one year before the NCAA, so next year will be their 50th meet) whn Central Methodist senior Drew Gandy leaped 4.60m/15-1, 8 bars higher in the vault.

Southern Oregon soph Joe Dotson raced the second place with a terific 1500m effort, nipping Lawson by 3 points. Interestingly Dotson did not win the final event....Pieter Top, a Westmont freshman (Wiolsonville, OR) did in 4:21.07.

A year ago Doane's Kale Wolken had broken the meet record with an eye-opening 7830 score. Nothing like that this time around, but the 6-3 Lawson seemed to have things well in hand after leading at the break and fashioning a nice 14.66 hurdle race. But a

3.80m/12-5½ muted his score. Idaho State transfer Nikola Andjelic, a Croatian junior at Rio Grande, was 4th
