FINALLY, A BREATHER Götzis, Small Colleges, OTC Meets Next

HELLO AGAIN..... After several frantic weeks of non-stop decathlon action (consider: 76 meets in May so far, 68 of them collegiate conference affairs and I think we've detailed them all) we finally got a breather during the recent week where only four meets were conducted.

The top score was recorded by Gabe Moore, a freshman at South Plains College who won the National JUCO meet in Levelland. His 7097 winning total was more than 600 points up on his closest competitor. Simpson junior Isaac Frazier won the Gregory 'last chance' meet in Naperville with a qualifying 6504 effort.

The anticipated match-up between WR holder Ashton Eaton and Olympic sprint champ Usain Bolt/JAM did not come off. On his 2nd long jump in Ostrava, after a 7.55m/24-91/4 opener at the Golden Spike meet, Ashton felt a twinge in quad ran thru the pit and shut it down, discretion being the better part of valor. Nothing serious, just being careful. He will not run the Prefontaine hurdles this week in Eugene.

But this week will see some significant action. Of course the main focus will be on the 42nd Hypo Bank meeting in Götzis, Austria where Canadian Damian Warner (running hot with a recent 10.07 +5.2 hurricane) will start. There is scuttlebut of a record try. Two Americans, Jeremy Taiwo, who PR'd in Götzis last year at 8303 for 6th, and Garrett Scantling will start. Taiwo has been inactive this spring. Götzis weather forecast is chilly and raw.

Stateside the CVOTC HP-2 meet in Chula Vista has gathered plenty of top names (aphabetically: Bahner, Barrolihet, Beach, Bray,Cato, Hardee, Morrison, Moss, Robinson, Weinstock) all looking for a Trials qualifier or tune-up. Should be hot. The same has occurred on the women's side since the heptathlon standard was unexpectedly raised by 250 points (5900 to 6150) creating a scramble by female heptathletes, many of whom thought they had already qualified for the Trials.

This is also 'small college' week as national championships at NAIA (Gulf Shores, AL), NCAA II (Bradenton, FL), and NCAA III (Wartburg College, Waverly, IA) are on tap for Thursday-Friday (26-27). A list of accepted enteries is provided below. In all approximately 80 decathletes will compete domestically.
