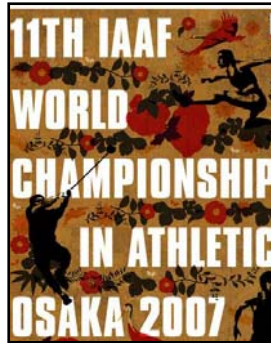

## Outlook for 2007 Meeting

The 11<sup>th</sup> IAAF world championship returns to the Orient after a 16 year absence. Dan O'Brien won the 3<sup>rd</sup> IAAF world title in Tokyo in 1991. Defending champion Bryan Clay appears healthy and ready for a big score. He won the 2005 title in Helsinki after garnering a silver medal at the 2004 Athens Olympic Games. In fact the 3 Athens' medalists are all healthy and primed for Osaka. Olympic champion (and world record holder-9026 in 2001) Roman Sebrle, 32, of the Czech Republic has the world's leading score (8697). Olympic bronze medalist Dmitry Karpov/Kazakhstan dnf'd the 1500m at Gotzis but returned with an 8553 effort in Kladno.

But all eyes will be on Clay who put up an 8493 effort in Gotzis for 3<sup>rd</sup> after cruising with a big lead. His snafu in the discus cost him 300+ points. He withdrew after 4 events at the USA nationals in Indianapolis but appears healthy and rare'in to go.

A pair of decathletes with dissimilar credentials could throw a monkey wrench into the Big Three. 21 year old Andrei Krauchanka of BelaRussia won the Gotzis affair with a huge PR 8617, then won the Euro under 23 crown. He's springy and has fresh legs. And Tom Pappas, 5 days shy of his 31<sup>st</sup> birthday, has returned to elite status. He was injured at the Athens Games in '04 and a shoulder injury did not allow him to defend his IAAF world title in 05. He won the crown in Paris in 2003. But Pappas has reclaimed the last two USA nationals to tie Bill Toomey and Dan O'Brien for the most USA national titles, 5.

Also returning from injuries will be former Kansas State U star Attila Zsivoczky/HUN, who was runner-up to Sebrle at the '06 Euro champs. As well, Pan American champion Maurice Smith, an NCAA champ from Auburn U and Jamaica, will be a contender although his jav elbow is suspect.

Other in the loaded field include 3 time champion Tomas Dvorak, now 35, who score 8000 points for the 35<sup>th</sup> time in his career in June.

A pair of additional Americans (the US gets 4 entrants b/c Clay gets a bye as defending champ) will make their presence felt, especially in the vault. Paul Terek, who won MultiStars in Desanzano in May (8134) and newly crowned NCAA champ Jake Arnold of the University of Arizona (8215), are terrific vaulters, both capable of over 5.30m/17-4½

The feature (and possibly turning) event of the meet will be the discus where Clay owns the world best score, but at least 6 others are capable of tossing over 51 meters. Smith's recent Pan-Am 53+m toss in Rio de Janeiro was eye-opening.

Americans and a Czech have been prominent at the Worlds, having won the last 8 titles. The US has a two meet win streak (Pappas and Clay).

### Summary:

In 2007 dnf'd at USA champs after placing third at Götzis with 8493 in spite of discus snafu. Bryan opened 2006 outdoor season with a victory at Götzis (8677), the first American victory there ever. He had been runner-up at the IAAF world indoor heptathlon. 'Dnf'd at USATF in Indianapolis due to dehydration.

Bryan's 2004 year was a dream. Not only did he capture the US Olympic Trials with a PR score of 8660, but he then won the silver medal at the Olympic Games in Athens behind Roman Sebrle with an 8820 score, becoming America's 23<sup>rd</sup> Olympic decathlon medalist. Of Americans, only Dan O'Brien has ever scored more. Bryan then was 2<sup>nd</sup> (again to Sebrle) at France's DecaStar to capture 2<sup>nd</sup> in the IAAF Grand Prix Combined Events Challenge. And only at 25!

2005 was even better as Bryan won a 2<sup>nd</sup> USA championship (using a world best 55.87m discus sling in the process) followed by the IAAF world title in Helsinki (8732 pts), all of which notched him a #1 world ranking for the season. He opened the 2006 campaign with a silver medal at the IAAF indoor championships in Moscow.

Bryan was 1999 National USATF Junior champion and Pan-American Jr Champion as freshman at Azusa Pacific where he is coached by Kevin Reid. As a sophomore (2000) he was both NAIA indoor pentathlon and outdoor decathlon champion. Made dramatic breakthrough in April, 2001 with 7980 PR win at Mount SAC Relays, then placed an eye-opening 3<sup>rd</sup> at the USATF nationals. Injured he dnf'd the IAAF Worlds in Edmonton and was 13 a World University Games in Beijing, China. In 2002, after knee surgery in April, he recovered quickly and was 2<sup>nd</sup> at USATF nationals with PR 8230, the nation's leading collegiate score.

He opened the 2003 campaign with a world leading 8225 effort at Atlas then made the USATF champs a 'breakthrough' affair getting 8482 points behind Tom Pappas. It earned him a world ranking. A leg injury curtailed his IAAF world champs meet.

Bryan opened the 2004 indoor meet with a 3<sup>rd</sup> at Estonia's Reval Cup and then was runner-up at the IAAF world champs in Budapest with an eye-opening 6365 score. He notably upped his long jump PR to 8.05m/26-5 in June, 2004. Has won 10 of 26 career meets.

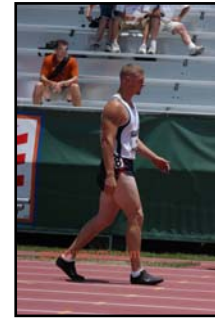

In 2007 Paul won the USA national indoor heptathlon for a record 3<sup>rd</sup> time, then posted a major international win in Desanzano, Italy at MultiStars with an 8134 effort, best since 2004. He then was runner-up at the USA nationals with his 6<sup>th</sup> career 8k effort. In 2005 Paul placed 4<sup>th</sup> at Multi-Stars in Salo and 3<sup>rd</sup> at the NACAC meet in San Juan with a 7923 effort before garnering a runner-up place at the U.S. nationals (7976). He was subsequently 13<sup>th</sup> at the IAAF World champs and 12<sup>th</sup> at DecaStar. Paul was runner-up at the 2006 USA indoor champs at Chapel Hill, then opened outdoors with a 7822 performance at the Jim Click meeting in Tucson. After a 'dnf' at Götzis Paul placed 5<sup>th</sup> at USATF in Indianapolis.

Paul opened 2004 outdoor season with 8<sup>th</sup> place at Gotzis (8161) then won the Olympic team's final spot with a dramatic finish in the 1500m (recorded a PR) in the 'Battle of Michigan' over Phil McMullen. Indoor he defended his national heptathlon title.

Paul opened the 2003 indoor season with a 5.70m (18-8¼) vault, then placed 8<sup>th</sup> at the USATF indoor nationals in the vault. He then captured the USATF indoor heptathlon crown (5870) and was 3<sup>rd</sup> at MultiStars in Desanzano. At the 2003 outdoor nationals in Palo Alto he racked up 5 lifetime bests to score 8275 for rd behind Tom Pappas and Bryan Clay, thereby making the USA World Championship team. A hurdle 'dq' cost him 4<sup>th</sup> place at IAAF world champs.

Paul was a double Big Ten champion in 2001 winning both the indoor heptathlon (5685 with 5.40m pv)) and outdoor decathlon (7695). Hen was also the Big 10 indoor vault champ and has a 5.56m (18-2 3/4 PR). He then placed 4<sup>th</sup> at the NCAAs with 7645 getting =MR 5.40m vault.

Was NCAA indoor vault runner-up in '02, then won Mt SAC Relays with PR 7926 and Big Ten crown again with 7829 score. At NCAAs in Baton Rouge he became 55<sup>th</sup> American to score over 8000 by placing 2<sup>nd</sup> with 8041 total. He was subsequently 9<sup>th</sup> at the USA nationals.

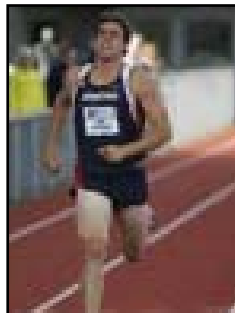
