SUDBECK^{NAIA}, PLY^{NJCAA} ON TOP Duckworth 2nd at Euros, NCAAs Next

Hello Again..... We are now engaged in the national championship stage of the indoor heptathlon season. A pair of nationals, NAIA and NJCAA, were held over the weekend. The coming week will see the three NCAA divisions conduct their nationals and a pair of prep nationals are also on the docket.

Doane University junior Levi Sudbeck (Hadar, NE), was an upset winner at the NAIA indoor heptathlon in Brookings, SD (2/28-3/1). A veteran field (nine returnees) lined up at South Dakota State including defending champion Winston Lawson of Vanguard and runner-up Pieter Top of Westmont. Seasonal leader Cody Williams, a soph from Neb-raska's Concordia was also in the hunt but Sudbeck exhibited notable improvement in vault skills (from 4.30m/14- $1\frac{1}{4}$ to 5.00m/ 16-4\frac{3}{4}). By the time the vault was completed Sudbeck had caught the entire field and owned a 62 point margin on Williams and 151 on Lawson. He stayed reasonably close in the 1k and the final tallies read: Sudbeck 5273; Williams 5231; Lawson 5143. Westmont's Top used middle distance skills (2:37.54) to close the gap and was just 6 points back of Lawson at the finish.

Ninth in the previous pair of indoor nationals, Sudbeck improved in each of the seven disciplines over his 2018 performance. The win by Sudbeck represented the 5th for Doane in the past 7 years.

The national junior college meet in Pittsburg, KS (3/1-2 was entirely a two man affair. Central Arizona soph Jonathan Ply and

Mesa CC soph Marcus Naisant split the first six events with the latter holding a 14 point lead. But Ply's 20 second margin in the 1000m gave him a 187 point win, 5350 to 5163.

Current NCAA I indoor champ Tim Duckworth, Kentucky'18, who competes for Britain, was runner-up at the European indoor champs in Glasgow (3/2-3) with a nifty 6156 score. Eye-opening was an 7 second PR in the 1000m (2:49.44). He finished 62 points back of Spain's Jorge Urena.

Friday-Saturday, March 8-9 find the NCAA I champs in Birmingham, AL; the D-II meet in Pittsburg, KS, and the D-III champs at the Reggie Lewis Center in Boston.
