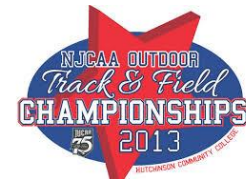
Smaller Colleges, Götzis next

Hello Again....The calm before the storm. The 3rd week of May, 2013 witnessed the final Junior College title affairs and some last minute D-III qualifying meets. In all, a restful weekend.

Favorite Paul Tonneson of Arizona's Mesa CC captured a 2nd NJCAA crown with a 7102 win in Hutchinson, KS. Juan Vasquez/South Plains (6537) was the runner-up. And Steve Dorset of Monterey College became the California Community College champ with a 6759 win at San Mateo. 28 JCers competed in the two championship meets.

The rest of the week shaped the NCAA III qualifying lists as forty went to the starting line at 4 sites. The Gregory Invitational at North Central College in Naperville, IL added 4 to the D-III lists with Simpson College's (IA) John Cord getting the victory (6494); the ECAC III in Springfield, MA was won by Clay Kosack of the Coast Guard Academy (6384).

Next week promises plenty of action. The Hypo-Bank meeting in Götzis, Austria (Saturday-Sunday, May 25-26) will feature some of the world's best while the smaller institutions (NCAA II, III and NAIA) all conduct nationals on Thursday-Friday, May 23-24.
