INTERNATIONAL SEASON

Asian, Euro u23, WUG Titles Decided

Hello Again... Early July is normally a down time for American decathlon action so the major news is international. A trio of important international titles were decided recently. On July 3-4 32 year old Dmitriy Karpov won the Asian Championships in Pune, India with an 8037 total.

A few days later (7/8-9) Kazan, Russia hosted the World University Games. Thomas Van Der Plaetsen/BEL (8164 points) was an easy winner over Russian star Sergey Sviridov and New Zealand's Brent Newdick. Former Big12 champ Lars Vikan Rise, a Norwegian '12 grad from Missouri, was 4th in an eleven man field. 7th place NCAA II finisher Henrik Holmberg, a Norwegian at Augustana (SD)

College, was 9th with a PR 6850 score.

There was a heavy US collegiate connection at the 9th European under 23 Champs in Tampere, FIN on July 11-12. The



large field (30 declared, 28 starters) included NCAA I champ Johannes Hock/Texas-GER

and '12 NCAA I scorer Petter Olson/Texas-SWE, both of whom failed to finish as did Pac-12 scorer Viktor Fajoyomi/HUN-USC.

'11 Thorpe Cup winner Kai Kazmirek/GER held off fast charging Russian star Ilya Shkurenkov, 8366 to 8279 in an affair that saw four exceed 8k. Recent Euro Cup winner Kevin Mayer/FRA did not start.



22 year old Kai Kazmirek/GER scored a whopping 8366 points to win the World University Games crown in Tampere, FIN. His marks included a 46.98 one lapper.

Finally, 48 (!) year old Kip Janvrin, in a mini comeback, won the USA Masters Pentathlon (age 40-49) in Olathe, KS on July 11. His age adjusted 4079 score was eye-

opening and, on the current IAAF tables converts to 3233 and actually leads the nation for the event.
