Fields Set for Major Meets

Hello Again.....The fields are set for the Hypo Bank International in Götzis, Austria and the upcoming national collegiate meets (NCAA and NAIA). At Götzis meet director Konrad Lerch has assembled the deepest field yet and we list the 35 invitees. Three Americans are in the field: Bryan Clay and Trey Hardee will open here, their first CE competition since going 1-2 at the IAAF world indoor champs in Doha, Qatar; as well as 2010 MultiStars winner Jake Arnold. 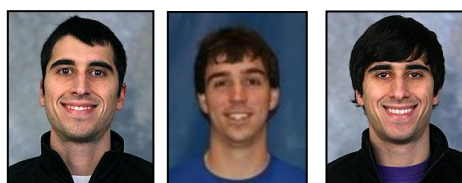

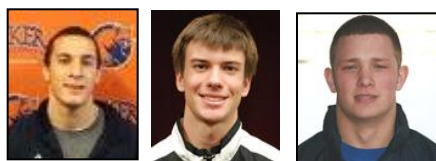
