We are following the US small college affairs vis long distance and this report offers coverage of the first day, from Kingsburg, TX (D-II), Geneva, OH (D-III) and Gulf Shores, AL (NAIA). NCAA D-II TAMU-Kingsville, TX May 23, 2019

Although Texas has experienced multiple floodings in recent weeks, the weather in Kingsville, just south of Corpus Cristi on the Gulf coast, was hot, humid and



windy. Seasonal leader Valentin Charles, a freshman from France, did not start.

When competition got underway it was Embry Riddle senior Lonnie Marts who had complete control following a fine 14.36m/47-1½ shot. Kingsville soph Johnathon Harper captured the sprint (10.81) while Central Missouri freshman Trey Miller won the horizontal jump at 7.52m/24-8¼. Angelo State's Croatian frosh Trpimir Siroki took the overall lead with a 2.03m/6-8 high jump clearance and went on to add three additional bars pushing his score to 3255 and a 96 point overall lead.



Siroki (left) gave up the first day lead (53.40 400m) to teammate Alexandros Spyridonidis /Greece, 3942 to 3920 as Angelo State stood 1-2-5 and making an impact on team scoring.

SPIRE Institute, Geneva, OH
May 23, 2019**

The immaculate facilities at SPIRE in Geneva provided the perfect backdrop for the D-III Champs where Central (IA)'s Will Daniels was defending and the overwhelming favorite. A thunderstorm took down the city's power grid in Geneva just before the start of day one.

After three events Daniels already had built up a 120 point advantage over Eau

His five event margin over Cooper exploded to 259 points after a 50.51 400m.

Pieter Top, the Westmont junior, (right) saw his lead diminish to just 12 points after a weak high jump. But he redeemed himself with 49.56 one lap clocking and led at the break with a 3774 score. His 10.54 clocking in the century was the meets's fastest in years. Dickinson State's Cleet Wrzesinski handled the long jump at 7.01m/23-0 while Reagan Shitra/Corban was the shot victor at 12.37m/40-7. Tall Levi Sudbeck/ Doane won the high jump at 1.99m/6-6¼



Top topped the first section of the

400m in 49.56 while the dogged Wrzesinski, pressing all the way, won the 2nd in 49.99.

Top led

Wrzesinski at the break was a scant 32 points, 3774 to 3742.
