WARNER in a FOUR-PEAT

Lindon Victor 2nd as Götzis Nets 15 8000 Scores

Hello Again.... At the break two of the highest scoring decathletes in Götzis history had withdrawn. Trying to turn back the clock Rico Freimuth/GER () and Elco Sintnicolaas/NED () were on the back nine of their careers. But ?? of the original 34 were at the hurdles starting line on Sunday as the local church bells tolled at 10:00 am. Cloudy and overcast conditions, but no forecast of rain (Whew!). Canadian Damian Warner started the day with a substantial lead and was an overwhelming favorite to capture a 4th consecutive Götzis title (one shy of Roman Sebrelé's record).

He did so with 5 solid marks and piled up an 8711 score, 84 under his winning mark and national record a year ago. SBTC's Lindon Victor was 2nd with a 8473 effort and Estonia's Maicel Uibo 3rd at 8353. 15 surpassed 8000. Tim Duckworth was 17th at 7981, Devon Williams 19th at 79234 and Tim Ehrhardt 25th at 6851.

Aussie Ashley Moloney, still 18, was the meet's 'Rookie' with a 8038 score.

The crowd at the start of day #2 was approximately 3000 with temps in low 60s°



Canadian Damian Warner won his 4th consecutive Hypo-Bank trophy and nailed a solid 8711 score.

F. It would reach a pleasant 70° by mid-afternoon. There were a few holes in the heat sheets since some athletes withdrew overnight.

Tim Ehrhardt was in the first of six hurdle races. He was 4th in 15.74 as Belgium's Neils Pittomvils won in 14.85. The second race was won by Tim Nowak/GER (14.64) as Karl-Robert Saluri, ex-Georgia dropped out before the first barrier. Maicel Uibo/EST and Marcus Nielsson/SWE raced side-by-side (lanes 3&2) in the 3rd race finishing 2nd and 3rd behind Manuel Eitel/Ger PR 14.42.

Lindon Victor in lane 6 was troubled by a ragged trail leg and was 5th in the next race in a seasonal best 14.86, a battle won by German Kai Kazmirek in 14.39.

In the 5th race all eyes focused on young Ashley Moloney who had won last year's world juniors and who stood in 2nd behind Warner at the break. He was 2nd in 14.24 behind Jorge Urena's 13.99. Tim was

4th in 14.44, .14 off a PR. Good start....day two.

In the seeded section Warner drew lane #4 with Devon Williams on his left. Warner was clear after just two hurdles and he ran tall and smoothly to a 13.64 clocking into a slight head wind (-0.7mps). Williams held off an ANA, Artem Makarenko, 14.00 to 14.04. Damian's lead grew to 228 points.

Discus: [11:17 -12:07 pm]

Group B is always placed behind the west grandstand. Tim Ehrhardt plated a nice 39.21m/128-7 and the event was won by Sweden's Frederick Samuelsson at a PR 45.19m/148-3. The 19 year old Moloney also had a career best (still a short career) tossing 41.98m/137-8.



Lindon Victor took the discus with a nice 54.03m/177-3 toss and momentarily held the overall lead.

In discus Group A, inside the stadium, with distance lines set at 40m, 45m and 50m(164-0). Duckworth opened with a solid 42.22m/138-6 toss. Lindon Victor was looking for redemption from last year's meet where his 48.82m/160-2 was a major disappointment. Would today be different? His seasonal best was 55.87m/183-3 so he

was looking for a big mark. And he got one at the end of round #1 (5152m/169-0, a mark that moved him to the overall lead since Warner's first effort flopped out just 35.18m/115-5. Lindon had the lead, 6154 to 6085. Warner's first toss was the only event drama and he took back the lead in round #2 at 46.25m/151-9. Victor responder with a winning 54.03m/177-3 toss but was still 104 out of the lead. Group A ended with a wimper as ten of 17 recorded fouls in the final round. *After Seven: Warn 64312, Vict 6207, Molo 6085, Kazm 6002, Eite 5966, Duck 5921.....9th Uibo 5880,....19th Will 5722...25th Ehrh 5372.*

Pole Vault: [1:00 - 3:35pm]

At the start, with overcast conditions, the crowd swelled to about 3500. Looking shaky, Victor missed twice at 4.40m/14-1/4, his opening height. The problem was too slow in his final three steps, making it difficult to penetrate the pit. But a clutch 3rd try save a fine score. It took him a pair of tries to get over the next bar. He looked even better at 4.60m/15-1. Warner started here, missed on his first and was more careful clearing on his 2nd try. Victor, using a short approach and Williams a much longer one, were both unsuccessful in round #1 at 4.70m/15-5. Ditto round #2. Then both cleared on 3rd attempts. It took a 3rd desperation try for Victor and a 2nd for Williams to negotiate the next bar, 4.80m/15-9. At this point Victor had cut Warner's lead to 165 points.

At 2:30 pm the sun made a brief appearance. Williams retired but Victor continued to compete (he took 15 vaults in 110 minutes. 4.90m/16-3/4 having finally proved too much.

Dominic Distelberger/AUT at 5.00m/16-4 3/4 .

In Group A Duckworth opened at 4.70m/15-5 with an easy clearance and moved smoothly through 4.90m/16-3/4. He went no higher. After one hour and 45 minutes Tim Ehrhardt started with an easy clear over 5.00m/16-4 3/4.
