

INDOOR CAMPAIGN HEATS UP

Hasslebroek, Moore, Simmons, Erm, Run Up Big Numbers

Hello Again..... The 2018-19 indoor campaign has finally heated up during the last weekend of January as 32 indoor heptathlons dotted the card.

In his first USA appearance as a US collegian Gary Haasbroek, an Australian freshman at Texas-San Antonio, piled up 5949 points to win the U of Houston Inv. His winning marks included....

All but the shot put were career bests. Haasbroek, 2 months shy of his 20th birthday is (DOB: 15 March 1999) was last year's IAAF world junior runner-up (7798) in Tampere. He is a transfer from LaTrobe University and has competed as a professional trampoline gymnast at three junior world championships and captured a pair of bronze medals. He'll be coached at UTSA by Aaron Fox.

In other weekend meets Arkansas senior Gabe Moore (23, Freeport, FL) came away with an NCAA qualifier by posting a 5865 (9 points shy of his '18 NCAA PR 6th place effort) total to win at Fayetteville's Razorback. New Zealand soph Aaron Booth/Kansas St (22, Auckland) also PR'd, 46 points back of Moore.

On the previous weekend vet Solomon Simmons ran up a 5825 score to win the Samford Invitational in Birmingham. Other top efforts came from Georgia soph Johannes



In his initial USA Combined Events, Australian Gary Haasbroek had six event PRs and won in Houston with 5949 points.

Erm (21, Tallinn, EST) whose 5805 won the Pollack meet at Clemson.

Teddy Frid, a Minnesota grad who won the Jack Johnson meet in Minneapolis with 5564; former Chico star Phil Bailey/SBTC was the star at the University of Washington affair in Seattle (5615); Ayden Owens, a USC frosh on the Texas Tech meet in Lubbock at a PR 5632.

Estonian freshman Kristo Simulask /Okla St (5516), Derek Jacobus/Arkansas (5656) and vet Jack Flood (5505) also came away with eye-opening weekend scores. Westmont junior Pieter Top collared the season's top NAIA score at 5165.

In all there were 32 5000+ performances in the weekend's 32 indoor

heptathlons and now the record keeping gets serious.
